FY20 STATISTICS




WHO USES THE LIBRARY?

2019-20 ANNUAL CIRCULATION




LIBRARY CARDHOLDERS

SUMMER READING PROGRAM

Although our summer didn't go as planned, the library was able to offer a Grab N Go style Summer Reading Program. Kids were able to pick up weekly activity bags/reading logs and participate in online Zoom Story Times. In addition, we created a Story Walk around our town square and participated in the Produce Box Project.

LIBRARY

Summer of 2020 saw the library receive accreditation from the State Library of Iowa for meeting the required standards. Two state funded services, IA Shares, a courier service which delivers library materials throughout the state and WhoFi, wifi data analysis, was introduced.

FURNITURE

Furniture throughout the library was upgraded, including two custom built computer work stations, a children's computer table and two chairs, a DVD binder shelving unit, and an adult rocking chair. In addition, four new computer chairs were purchased.

TECHNOLOGY

New computers, including an AWE Early Learning Station, a lap top, and a all-in-one computer were purchased. In addition, Botley, a coding robot, was bought for in house use and the database, Brainfuse HelpNow, was added to our online resources. Syndicated was added to our online catalog, including reader's advisory.

PROGRAMS

FY 2020 saw many programs for children and adults. Early out BINGO, STEM, and LEGO Robotics were a success as well as Preschool Story Time. Adults enjoyed a variety of programs, Culinary History of Iowa and Paranormal Activity, and local authors, Linda McCann and Lyle Gibson.

UPDATED WEBSITE

The State Library of Iowa has offered new website platforms to Iowa libraries and West Point will be taking part in this update. The new site will feature a user friendly layout and enable access on a wide range of mobile devices.

CRICUT

Thanks to a generous patron donation, we have a new Cricut Maker. Plans are to train staff, hold programs for patrons, create library materials, purchase additional supplies, and develop a policy for library use.
